

CORE VALUES

We pursue making disciples according to our mission and ministry model. Our core values can be understood by every member and are to unify all levels of High Point Church leadership across all events and ministries.

GOSPEL-CENTERED

The Gospel is the message of God's redemption of all who trust the work of the crucified and risen Jesus to be their righteousness, holiness and redemption. The work of the church is to offer and apply this message.

BIBLICAL INTEGRITY

The Bible is the word of God written, the measure of all Christian doctrine, and its message is the foundation of all spiritual growth and discipleship. We value the centrality of Scripture in all our ministries and promote Biblical literacy among all age groups.

FORMATIONAL COMMUNITY

We believe that spiritual growth and mutual care happen best in the context of genuine loving relationships. We intentionally encourage team-oriented ministry and small group fellowships, while discouraging anonymous attendance and disconnected leadership.

SACRIFICIAL SERVICE

Generosity is the result of gospel motivation and the price of influence. Sacrifice is therefore necessary to make the gospel believable to many who are skeptical, and to accomplish the work of ministries that save the lives and souls of those whom Christ sacrificed his own life to save.

CONTEXTUALIZATION

The Gospel has the greatest impact when it answers the questions people are asking related to the intellectual and emotional world in which they live. We believe that the unchanging truth of the Gospel must be expressed in ways that relate to the people we are trying to reach.

STRATEGIC PURSUITS

Strategic pursuits are developmental goals that require consistent, competent and energetic leadership for a church to become a model church, capable of creating a renewing and reforming surplus: a "teaching church."

EVANGELISM

We have a convictional and active obedience to the disciplines of spiritual hospitality, proclamation of the Gospel, and alleviation of obstacles for those who haven't yet accepted Jesus. We explicitly make an invitation to a decision and to baptism to help people become Christ's disciples.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

We are making, preparing and deploying surplus leaders and stewards, and emphasizing ministry leadership and integration with marketplace vocations.

PURSUIT OF UNITY

We are working to break down the dividing walls of hostility inhibiting love between believers and all our neighbors—even our enemies. Dividing walls include: generational, racial, cultural, linguistic, socio-economic/class and national boundaries.

BEING A PART OF SOMETHING BIGGER

We pursue being a part of something bigger than ourselves by helping, encouraging, training, sending and planting, in order to reform, renew, and expand disciples-making communities through the local church.

TEACHING CHURCH

We are training pastors, elders, and lay-leaders for local church leadership in a transient city.

GLOBAL MISSIONS

We are sending and supporting workers into cross-cultural and cross-linguistic ministry to predominantly unreached peoples.

We are supporting God's leaders who are already serving in churches on both a local and global level.

PARTNERSHIP INVESTMENTS

We are partnering with healthy yet underdeveloped or under-resourced churches to help them reach their potential.

PLANT CHURCHES

We are branching out in new, increasingly independent, disciple-making communities in our region.

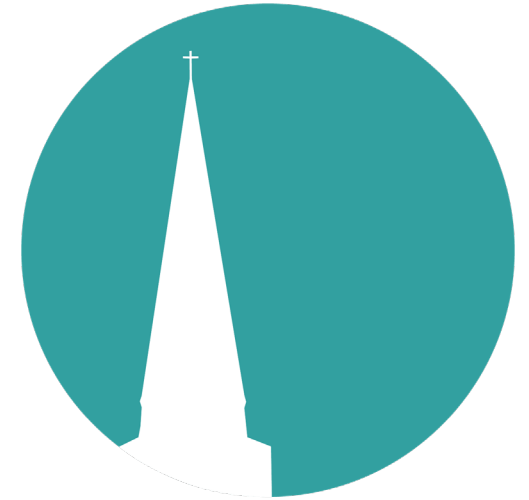
